Update from WBC Coach Luke Tanner

Even with the heaviest snowfall we've seen in a long time attendance to our club nights have exceeded our expectations. Because of this we have now arranged to add new sessions at Gwyn Evans leisure Centre in Gwersyllt, which will start Wednesday April 11th 6-7:30pm. We are restricted to 2 courts, which means we will have to restrict numbers, but we will be working hard to extend that if the sessions are successful. We are also looking forward to next season, where we are working with Badminton Wales to create a Satellite Centre, which will provide players with additional training and the next step on the Badminton Wales Performance Pathway.

Just a reminder that session costs are £4 per session. There is also an annual registration fee of £10 where players receive Sport and Recreational Liability Insurance, Personal Accident Insurance, access to league competition and individual tournaments and also helps fund WBC to develop badminton across Wrexham.
